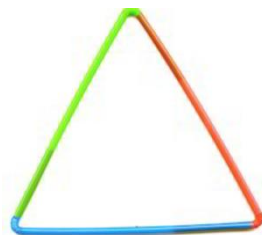
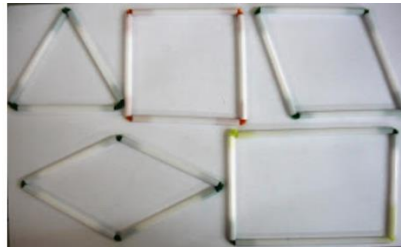
Shapes

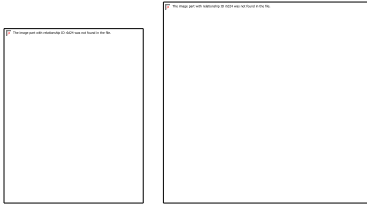

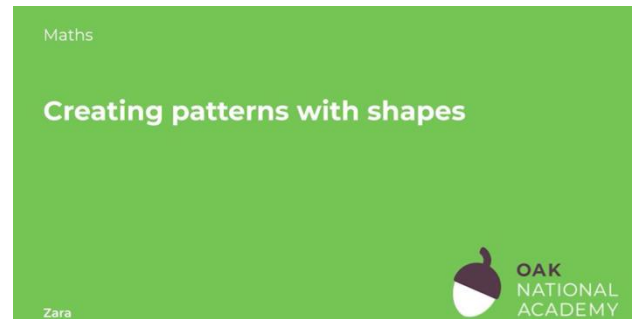
