Reception Remote Learning Grid

Please use this home learning grid to direct your child's learning while school is not open.

Learning activities are listed by day, with each day consisting of an English, Maths and Topic / Science activity. Activities are designed to consolidate learning that has already taken place, while also allowing children to start to think about learning that will be taking place during the summer term. There are three activities set each day. Activities should be completed in the provided remote learning book.

Within your child's home school communication book you will find your child's user and name and passwords for specific online learning resources, which are provided by the school. These resources can be used to support the learning.

Regular Reading, Spelling and Maths (At least 3 times per week)

In addition to the daily learning activities, your child should continue to practice their reading, spelling and numbers at least three times per week.

- The High Frequency Words your child is learning to read and write are in the back of their reading record. Your child should practice reading and writing these words daily.
- Using the 100 square, your child can practice counting to 20 and beyond. Your child can also practice writing the numbers.
- Your child has been provided with a school reading book, please continue to read this with them or read a book which is appropriate for their age which you may already have at home.

Daily Phonics Lessons

Ruth Miskin will be scheduling free Read Write Inc. Phonics lessons from Monday 23rd March. Children will be able to watch the sessions at home on Facebook and Youtube. There are three short Speed Sound Lessons with one of their trainers every day for the next two weeks. Films will show at the times below and be available for 24 hours.

Set 3 Speed Sounds at 10.30am and again at 1.30pm

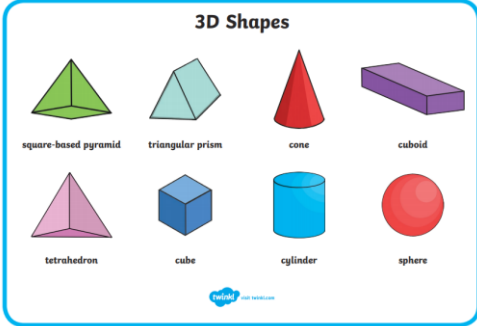

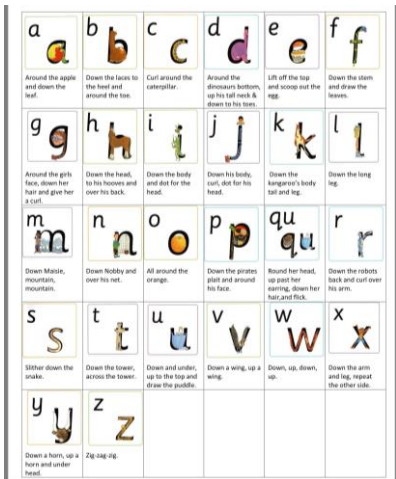
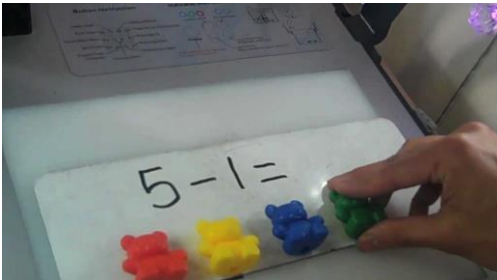
