 - *A high ropes course*

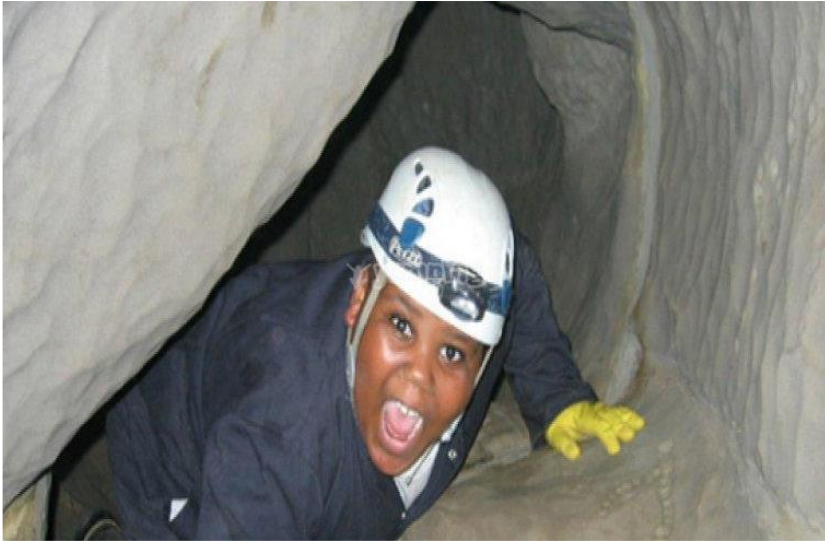

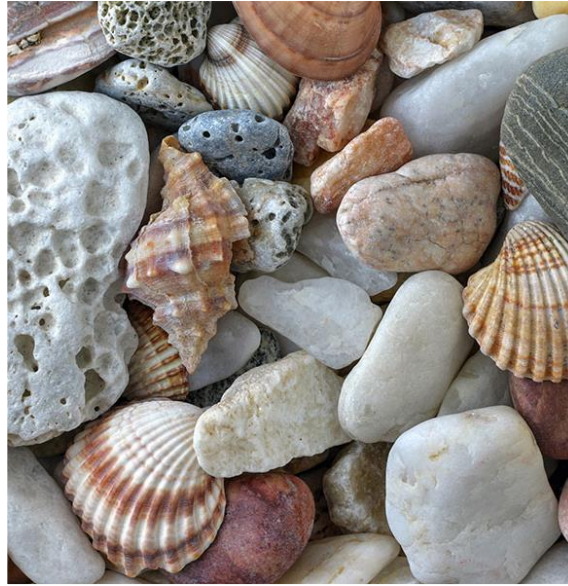

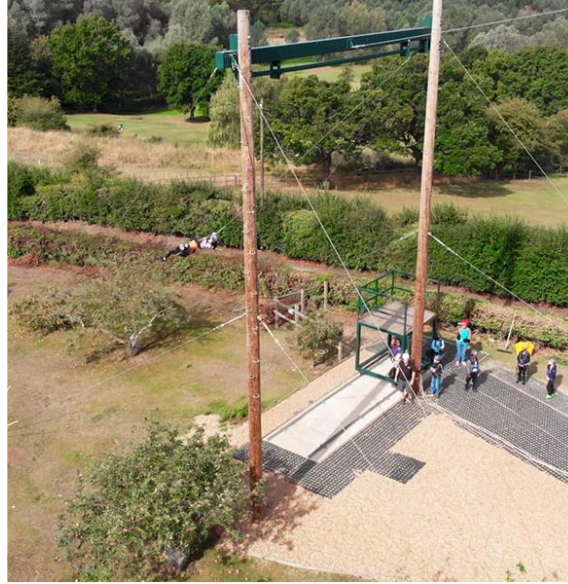
