- hotel, chalet, cottage, tent

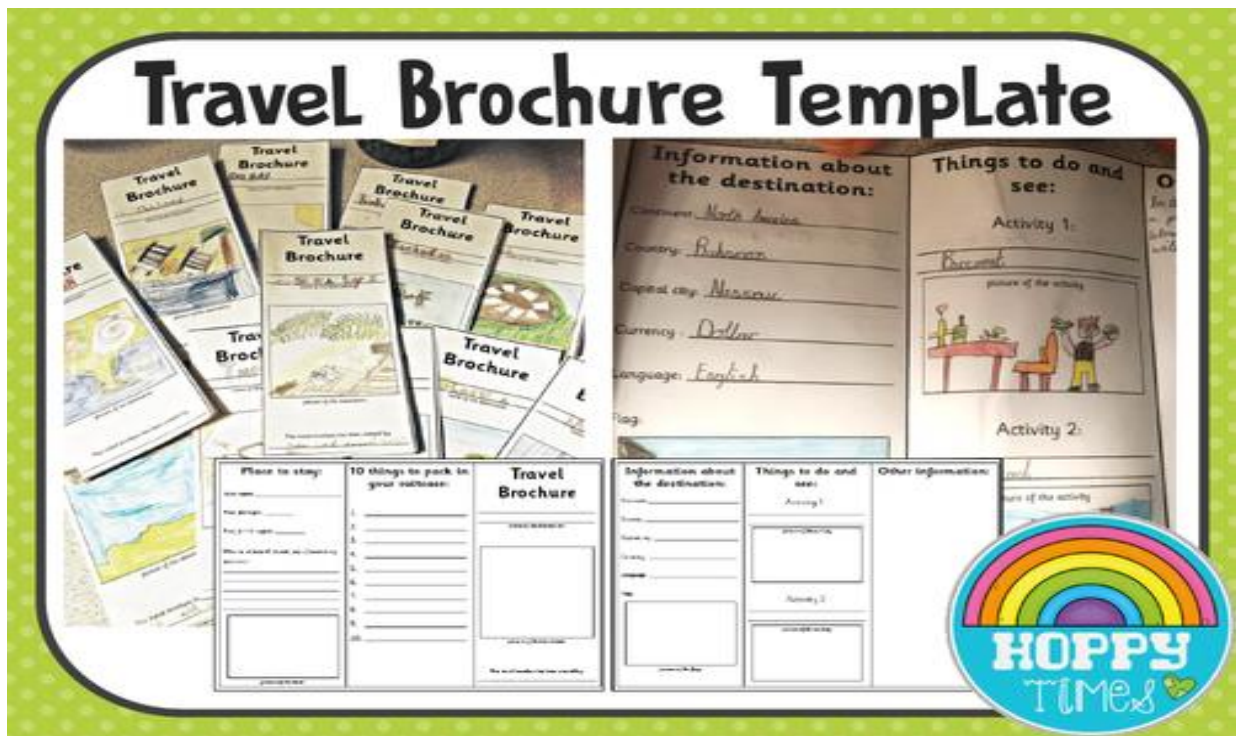


Think about what food you would like:

How to write a DIARY

WHO?

- First Person**
You are writing the diary from your perspective or in role, so use personal pronouns e.g. I/we
- Chronological Order**
Remember to sequence the events using fronted adverbials
- Past Tense**
Diaries mostly focus on what has already happened
- Chatty Style**
A diary is impersonal and friendly in tone

WHAT?

- Description**
Use vibrant language and lots of adjectives to help the reader build an image; simile and metaphors work well
- Style**
Include a date and perhaps start with... 'Dear Diary,...'
- Emotions**
Use evocative language
- Key Events**
Focus on significant experiences
