Spelling Bee 2026

During the course of the last month, the children from Year 1 – Year 6 have been competing in Gordon's 4th Spelling Bee.

Initially, every child participated in a whole class round which required them to learn a set of words which they were then tested on, in class. Following this, 8 children from each round went on to compete within the year group round. This round was run slightly differently with the children spelling the words out loud, rather than writing them. Not only did this allow the children to develop their spelling skills, but it was also a fantastic opportunity for them to develop their confidence when talking in front of a group, with particular awareness of how to project their voice.

Summer Reading Challenge

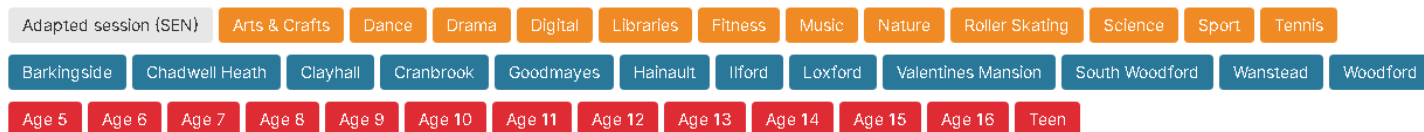
